Welcome home

Moving into a new home is a big change for a cat. Help them adjust smoothly with these simple tips.



CHOOSE THE RIGHT TIME

Ideally, welcome your cat over a weekend or during a period when you have time to dedicate to them.

A CONFINED SPACE AT FIRST

Limit their access to a single room so they can get used to it before gradually exploring the rest of the house.

STAY CALM AND BE RESPECTFUL

It's best to let your kitten explore their new environment at their own pace. As tempting as it is to cuddle, let them come to you and use treats to encourage gentle interaction. Avoid waking them while they sleep. Rest is essential for a growing kitten.

SHOW THEM THE ESSENTIALS

As soon as your cat arrives, make sure to place their food and water in one room, and their litter box in another. Avoid moving them around afterwards.



Eat well

A proper diet is essential for a cat's growth and health. It's important to follow the feeding chart on the packaging to adjust portions based on their age and weight.

LITTER BOX

Choosing the right box and type of litter is important to encourage your cat to use it. An open, shallow box makes access easier, and unscented litter is often better accepted. The litter box should be placed in a quiet area and cleaned daily to prevent odors and promote regular use.

Learn and play

Play stimulates a cat's natural instincts and helps them burn off energy. Balls, plush or feather toys encourage hunting, while interactive toys, such as treat dispensers, keep them active and mentally sharp.

A SCRATCHING POST

is essential for keeping your cat's claws healthy and protecting your furniture. A cat tree can also provide a space for resting and observing their surroundings. To keep them engaged, it's a good idea to rotate their toys and introduce new ones regularly.

Place the scratching post in a strategic location and offer different textures, such as sisal or cardboard, to keep your cat interested.

Sleep well

A cat sleeps an average of 12 to 16 hours per day.

Quality sleep is essential for their growth and well-being.

Their resting area should be quiet and secure.

A cushion, blanket, or hideout will provide optimal comfort.

Indoor or outdoor cat

A cat can live exclusively indoors or go outside, but each option requires certain precautions.



An indoor cat is safer. They avoid dangers such as cars, predators, and diseases. To stay stimulated, they need toys, scratching posts, and high places to climb.

A cat with outdoor access must be properly identified. Here are 3 ways to find them easily:

MICROCHIP: increases the chances of finding your cat if they get lost.

ID TAG AND BREAKAWAY COLLAR: display your contact information in case of need.

GPS TRACKER OR AIRTAG: helps track their movements.

Protecting your cat's health

Cats are sensitive to parasites and diseases. Proper prevention is essential for their well-being.

FLEAS: can cause itching. Regular treatment keeps them away.

DEWORMING: helps eliminate intestinal worms.

VACCINES: protect against serious diseases like panleukopenia (feline distemper) and calicivirus.

Consult your veterinarian to learn about recommended care.

TRIP TO GO

Whether it's for a vet visit or a longer trip, a cat should always be transported safely. A well-suited carrier is essential to protect them and prevent escape. To help them accept it more easily, gradually introduce the carrier by leaving it accessible at home with a blanket and a few treats.

When traveling by car, the carrier should be placed securely either on the floor behind a seat or fastened with a seatbelt.

TIPS & TRICKS

Partially covering the carrier with a cloth helps keep your cat calm during transport.

Never take them out of the carrier in the car to prevent the risk of escape.
